Dear Christian Families,

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. I hope this letter finds you well. I pray that your Christmas and New Year celebrations were joyous!

As we begin this new year, I would like to take this opportunity to invite you to a **special event** which will be held at St. Paul Lutheran School. This **special event** is our **Three, Four, and Five Year Old Early Childhood through 8th Grade Open House and Registration Day**. On Monday, January 21 from 9:00 am - 7:00 pm we will be sharing information on our two, three, four, and five year old kindergarten programs through 8th grade with prospective parents. You are invited to come with your child to visit the classrooms and meet the teachers.

All classrooms at St. Paul Lutheran School will be open and teachers will be available in the evening to answer any questions you might have about the school program at any grade level. If your child is currently enrolled in our early childhood program, we would invite you to visit our other classrooms and learn more about our elementary school program. I will also be in attendance to help answer any questions you might have.

Re-enrollment for the 2019-2020 school year will open January 11 for our current students through our new online enrollment process (TADS). Online link will be emailed to current families and available on our website.

- For **Pre-School** a \$75.00 per child non-refundable registration fee is required to ensure a place for your child.
- For **Kindergarten through 8th grade**, a \$100.00 per child non-refundable registration fee is required to ensure a place for your child. If enrolled on or before February 15, this non-refundable amount will be deducted from your tuition. After February 15, the non-refundable \$100.00 per child registration fee will be in addition to your tuition.
- Wisconsin Parental Choice Program: St. Paul will be participating in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program in 4K through 4th grade. The online application process for WPCP will open up February 1. Please complete the TADS application process prior to applying for WPCP. Current St. Paul families that are not in the Choice Program may apply if going into 4K, K and 1st grade. Below are the new income requirements for WPCP. Please contact me with any questions you have regarding the Choice Program.

It is our prayer that the Lord will lead you to provide your child with an educational experience with **“that something extra.”** That **“something extra”** we have at St. Paul is our **Lord, Jesus Christ**. Christ makes the difference in the education of the children that He has entrusted to our care. What better way to meet your child’s educational and spiritual needs than to educate them in an environment permeated with His love? ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Registration for members of St. Paul Lutheran Church will be processed first. Registration for non-members who are currently enrolled in our program will be processed second and non-members who are not currently enrolled in our program will have third choice. St. Paul Lutheran School will attempt to meet parents' needs and choices when placing students in specific sessions. You will be notified of your child's placement in February.

We will be utilizing an online enrollment process (TADS) for the 2019-20 school year. If you need assistance with enrollment, staff and computer stations will be available at the open house for your convenience. The link for online enrollment through TADS will be available on our school website by January 11, 2019.

APPLICATIONS RECEIVED BY JANUARY 22, 2019 WILL HAVE PRIORITY IN CLASS PLACEMENT. ANY APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE OPEN HOUSE WILL BE PROCESSED SEPARATELY.

FAMILIES WHO ARE ENROLLING THEIR CHILD FOR THE FIRST TIME AT ST. PAUL SCHOOL ARE REQUIRED TO BRING THEIR CHILD'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE WITH THEM TO THE OPEN HOUSE.

- **IF YOU ARE ENROLLING A CHILD IN OUR 2 PRE-K, 3 PRE-K OR 4 PRE-K PROGRAMS, A NON-REFUNDABLE \$75.00 REGISTRATION FEE IS REQUIRED WITH ENROLLMENT.**
- **IF YOU ARE ENROLLING A CHILD IN OUR KINDERGARTEN THROUGH 8TH GRADE PROGRAMS, A NON-REFUNDABLE \$100.00 REGISTRATION FEE IS REQUIRED WITH ENROLLMENT.**

STUDENTS MUST BE TWO, THREE, FOUR, OR FIVE YEARS OF AGE BY SEPTEMBER 1, 2019 AND ABLE TO USE RESTROOM FACILITIES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR ACCEPTANCE INTO OUR EARLY CHILDHOOD PROGRAMS. (2 PRE-K STUDENTS DO NOT NEED TO BE TOILET-TRAINED)

Two year old pre-kindergarten class consists of one session.

1. A two day session that meets on Tuesday and Thursday from 8:15 -10:45 am;

Three year old pre-kindergarten classes consist of three separate sessions.

1. A two day session that meets on Tuesday and Thursday from 8:15 -10:45 am; and
2. A three day session that meets on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:15 -10:45 am
OR from 12:30 – 3:00 pm.

Four year old pre-kindergarten classes consist of four separate sessions.

1. A three day session that meets on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 8:15 -10:45 am
OR from 12:30 – 3:00 pm; and
2. A five day session that meets Monday through Friday from 8:15 -10:45 am
OR from 12:30-3:00 pm.

Half-day (8:15 -11:45 am) and full-day (8:15 am - 3:12 pm) kindergarten classes for five-year olds operate on a Monday through Friday schedule.

1st through 8th Grade class schedule is from 8:15 am - 3:12 pm Monday through Friday.

Extended Care program is in operation year round, Monday through Friday, from 6:00 am until 6:00 pm.
