

## Members of Saint Paul

On Thursday March 19, the Saint Paul Church Council held our regularly scheduled meeting virtually and voted unanimously to postpone the scheduled April Quarterly Voters Meeting indefinitely. Once the restrictions on gatherings are lifted, the Council will reschedule the meeting and give the members the proper notification as required by our church constitution.

One of the items that is normally addressed at the April meeting is our Annual Church Budget. Our Director of Finance, Mr. Jason Hasenstein, is working with our Church Boards to finalize the numbers and complete the Budget process. Our fiscal year runs from July 1 to June 30 annually, so there will still be some time available for the review and approval process prior to our current budget expiring. In the event that Voters Meeting cannot be held before the current budget expires, your Church Boards and Council come up with a plan to continue to fund our operations and I will communicate that plan to the membership if that becomes necessary.

Finally, I ask that you continue to pray for and financially support Saint Paul as you are able. Even though we are restricted from gathering in person, our Church and School continue to function supported by our tremendous staff and workers. These are strange and difficult times, but rooted in Saint Paul and prayer, God will see us through.
