Ten Commandments Sculpture Dedicated April 25, 2021



With generous gifts and donations, St. Paul has commissioned artist and congregational member Andy Schumann to create the 10 Commandments bronze artwork.

The artwork depicts the 10 Commandment tablets Moses brought down from Mount Sinai. The empty cross reminds us that Christ took on our sins, died and rose again so that we may be forgiven and have eternal life.

This piece was originally created in clay with laser cut panels for the Commandments. The process to create the bronze is called Lost Wax Process. The process took several months and entailed the series of moles, wax work, ceramic shells, bronze castings, finishing and patina. The final piece weighs approximately 400 pounds and is attached to the wall with a French cleat system.
