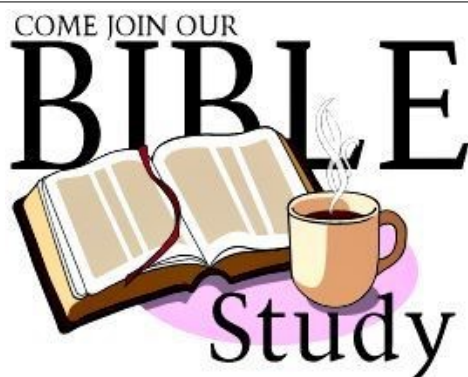

PASTOR WENDORF'S WEEKLY DEVOTION GO AWAY

Go away to the land of Judah and prophesy there. Amos 10:12

Have you ever told someone to go away, stop bothering me? When my grandson was younger, he would sometimes ask me to “go away.” There was something he wanted to do that he did not want me to see because he knew what I would say. When we sin, we are doing the same thing. We are saying, “go away” there is something I want to do or keep doing, and I do not want you, God, to tell me anything different. Amos heard these words from a king named Amaziah that he should “go away.” The king did not like the message of judgement and warning that Amos was speaking as a prophet from God. Let us ask the Lord to forgive us for the times we have said “go away” instead of listening and obeying. And do not be surprised that when you tell the truth and stand up for the word of God you may be told to “go away.”

EVERY GENERATION FAITHFUL TOGETHER—FAITHFUL TO THE FINISH



Mark your calendars for the South Wing decommissioning on **Sunday, June 8 following the 11am service**. The South Wing will be open after services on Saturday and Sunday and all are invited to do a final walkthrough, share memories and say farewell.

Progress on the new building is moving right along and we are getting closer to the completion of the ministry expansion project. For the last month, the committees reported the following:

Building Committee:

- The exterior has been completed with the exception of a couple of windows and doors.
- Finish grading is occurring on the east side of the building.
- Flooring has been mostly completed.
- Classroom cabinets and corridor cubbies have been installed.
- Mechanical finishes are nearly complete.
- Doors are being installed.

Next 30 days:

- Complete finishing touches on classroom addition.
- Punch list.
- Final construction cleaning.
- Prepare for south wing demolition, corridor and bathroom remodel to start after completion of the school year.

Finance Committee:

- As of April 30, 2025, St. Paul has paid more than \$4.4 towards the ministry expansion project. Approximately \$2.0 million remains to be paid to Catalyst Construction.
- More than \$1.8 million in promissory notes have been issued to date. For those interested, St. Paul continues to issue promissory notes.
- In April, St. Paul began borrowing from Lutheran Church Extension Fund (“LCEF”) to assist financing the remainder of the ministry expansion project through its completion. As of April 30, 2025, St. Paul has borrowed \$201,005 in principal and accumulated interest owed to LCEF of \$766.

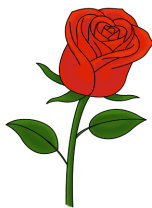

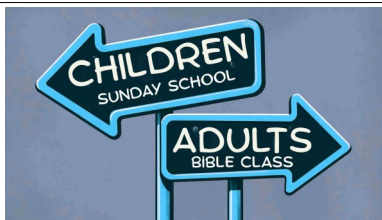


MOTHER'S DAY ROSE SALE— THIS WEEKEND MAY 10 & 11

On behalf of the Board of Parish Education, we would like to share an update for the Fall 2025 Sunday School hour. Starting in January our board began looking more in depth at our current Bible class offerings here at St. Paul along with the demographic those classes are reaching. We have several different offerings during the week at different times, but St. Paul does not offer any classes in which adults and kids can attend at the same time. We currently have Sunday school for 3 years olds to 6th graders at 8:15 – 9:15am and an adult class offered at 9:30am. As

a board we discussed and prayed how we could find ways to simultaneously serve all generations here at St. Paul and better align with our core values of Biblical Teaching and Authentic Relationships. As a result of these discussions, we unanimously voted to move the current 8:15 – 9:15am children's Sunday school to the same time as the adult class at 9:30am coming this fall. With this change there will be more class offerings running on Sunday to reach all generations. In addition, this will give us the opportunity for each age group to study the same topic at the same time leading to further discussions outside these church walls.
