CAPITAL CAMPAIGN MINISTRY EXPANSION EVERY GENERATION FAITHFUL TOGETHER

- 175TH ST. PAUL ANNIVERSARY**-funds to be used towards the celebration of St. Paul 175th Anniversary
- ALTAR GUILD**-support and purchase of supplies related to maintenance of church altars
- ARCHIVE/HISTORIC PRESERVATION**—funds used in the archival and historical preservation of church and school documents, photos and memorabilia relating to the history of our church and school
- ATHLETIC PROGRAM**—for the replacement of equipment or purchase of new equipment used by the young people of St. Paul in both the curricular PE area and the extra-curricular athletic areas
- AV/SANCTUARY**- Audio & visual system replacement/upgrades due to aging & failing equipment
- CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND**—for use by the Board of Parish Properties to make improvements and repairs to the facilities
- CEMETERY FUND**—for the upkeep and maintenance of the church owned cemetery
- CHRISTMAS DECORATION FUND**—purchase of flowers/decorations in and around the church at Christmas
- CHURCH LIBRARY**—for the purchase of books and materials for the adult library of the church
- CHURCH WORKER STUDENT AID FUND**—funds donated become part of an endowment fund. Annual accumulated interest is given to graduated St. Paul members who have become full-time workers in the church
- COFFEE MINISTRY**-support Sunday morning fellowship hour
- CONTEMPORARY WORSHIP**—for the purchase and maintenance of equipment and music
- DEBT REDUCTION FUND**—for interest and principal on the congregation’s building debt
- ENDOWMENT FUND**—per endowment bylaws, funds awarded annually based on St. Paul ministry needs
- FAMILY LIFE MINISTRY**—fund used to support the Family Life Ministry Program initiatives at St. Paul
- GOOD SAMARITAN PROGRAM**—tuition assistance for St. Paul Christian Day School families
- HANDBELL CHOIR**—for repair/replacement of hand-bells
- LUTHERAN EARLY RESPONSE TEAM (LERT)**-funds to support assistance efforts of St. Paul LERT team
- LIVESTREAM FOR WORSHIP**-funds used to livestream St. Paul weekly church services
- LWML**-support activities of St. Paul Lutheran Women’s Missionary League
- JOSHUA FUND**—offers financial assistance to families who send students to area LCMS high schools
- MISSION TRIPS**—funds used towards the various mission trips sponsored by St. Paul Lutheran Church
- MUSIC MINISTRY**—support ministry of all St. Paul musical groups including male, mixed, contemporary choirs
- ORGAN FUND**—funds to be used towards the continued maintenance of the church organ
- QUILTER’S OF ST. PAUL**—purchase of necessary supplies to support quilting projects for missions
- SCHOOL BAND PROGRAM**—to support the ongoing development of the school band program
- SCHOOL CURRICULUM**—funds during school year are designated for classroom curriculum improvements
- SCHOOL LIBRARY**— for the purchase of books and materials for the Christian Day School Library/IMC
- SCHOOL SCIENCE LAB**—purchase of supplementary science materials to enhance student’s experiences
- SHARING SHELF**—financial and material assistance to needy members and friends of the Congregation
- ST. PAUL YOUTH**—monies used to support the programs/activities of our St. Paul Youth Program
- TECHNOLOGY**-funds earmarked for the technology needs/upgrades of the Church and School
- WEEKLY WORSHIP FOLDER**-sponsor payment of the printing costs of the weekly bulletin.
