

St. Paul Lutheran School Student Christian Service Guide

WHAT IS COMMUNITY SERVICE?

The Christian Service Program at St. Paul Lutheran exists to provide our students the opportunity to put into practice the command of Jesus to "Love one another as I have loved you" through practical service to the people of St. Paul and the community of Grafton and its' surrounding area.

Community service is the idea of giving your efforts willingly and free of charge to an individual or organization that benefits from your help. Community service is not doing our chores (that's part of being a family) nor is it helping a business. Community service means that you are helping those without the resources to help themselves, or helping a non-profit agency.

HOW MUCH COMMUNITY SERVICE IS REQUIRED?

6th Grade: 5 hours (minimum) 7th Grade: 5 hours (minimum)

8th Grade: 10 hours (minimum)

WHEN CAN I COMPLETE MY COMMUNITY SERVICE?

Completion of community service can take place during the summer prior to entering 6th, 7th or 8th grade or during the school year. All documentation of community service must be turned in on or before May 1st of the specific school year.

WHAT ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF COMMUNITY SERVICE THAT I **MAY PERFORM?**

Church soup kitchen	Hospital and shut-in visitations
Civic outreach programs	Volunteer for a non-profit organization
Assisting in the library	Setting up/cleaning after church/school events
Running office errands	Maintaining class room bulletin boards
Campus clean-up	Assisting in Maintenance Department
Child care services (free babysitting)	Beach/Park clean-up projects
Tree planting	Neighborhood clean-up
Senior citizen project help	Charity assistance
Scorer or time keeper at events	Open house student volunteers
Maintaining flower gardens	Playground keep-up

WHAT ARE SOME EXAMPLES OF THINGS THAT WOULD NOT BE CONSIDERED SERVICE?

Doing jobs for your family Participating in a school activity Acolyte for church services Helping out a PROFIT business Receiving payment for your work Work that is required for another project

HOW DO I VERIFY MY COMMUNITY SERVICE HOURS?

- Student should complete his/her section of the Christian Service Verification Sheet.
- Volunteer supervisor is requested to sign and date the Christian Service Verification Sheet and write a contact phone number.
- Parents should verify the student's hours and sign and date the Christian Service Verification Sheet.
- > Return completed Christian Service Verification Sheet to the principal.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I DO NOT COMPLETE MY COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENT DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR?

At the end of the 3rd trimester students will receive a "P" (Pass) if they have completed their community service or an "F" (Failure) if they have not completed their hours on their final report card. This grade will be part of their permanent record from St. Paul.
