Attached are the Lutheran Junior Honor Society Service Hours Documentation Forms. Please adhere to the following guidelines:

- An essay on one of the following topics must be included with the application:

Show a person in your own life who demonstrates the qualities of leadership, service to others, **or** discipleship. **Provide** specific examples where this person has shown one (or more) of the qualities. Then **explain** why he or she serves as a role model for you. Finally, **conclude** your essay with how *you have and will show* that quality at St. Paul.

Choose any one of the three qualities -- leadership, service to others, **or** discipleship -- and provide an essay that **shows** how you have already chosen to demonstrate those qualities in your own life. Think of a time when you had a choice to make:

- will I lead, or will I follow,
- will I serve others when that was challenging, or
- will I choose to act with Christian character even when doing so can be difficult.

Explain that time. **Share** the challenge you faced, and **share** how you choose to lead, serve, or follow Christ. **Conclude** with how that experience will help you in your role as an LJHS member here at St. Paul.

- A signed letter of recommendation from a non-family member outside of the school community must be included with this form. **Returning members do not need this letter.**
- All forms should be printed and completed, including signatures.
- The same activity cannot be used as service hours for both Community Service and School/Church Service. For example, volunteering to serve as powerpoint operator can count as one or the other, but the one event may not count toward both categories. The only exception to this is volunteering for Vacation Bible School, serving all five days.
