
https://www.weareteachers.com/weird-fun-facts/ . I will share a few facts:





To gossip is to talk about other people's private lives. It is sharing information about someone that is not appropriate to be shared, or sharing information about another person that is not true (this is a rumor). Stop the gossip by asking the question, "Why are you telling me this?" This communicates that we are not interested in engaging in gossip. Friendzy Unit Seven helps students understand what gossip is and recognize the destructive nature of gossip in friendships.
