## A Relentless Spirit

The basis for my thoughts comes from Colossians 3:12 "Since God chose you as a holy people, clothe yourselves with mercy, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience"

What do you have left in the tank? When your head hits the pillow at bedtime, are you smoked? You should be. There are teachers who choose to coast into the summer. But should we? The countdown to summer vacation is exhilarating, but counting down the days left with students and making use of every second to impart wisdom and love in and over them is even more filling.


