



EVERY GENERATION FAITHFUL TOGETHER MINISTRY EXPANSION FUND UPDATE

Great progress has been made and, as summer begins, we are getting closer to the completion of the ministry expansion project. For the last month, the committees reported the following:

Building Committee:

- New building construction has been substantially completed.
- Punch list has been completed for all of the new classrooms and corridors.

Upcoming:

- Preparation for south wing demolition.
- Start of phase 2 remodel of the existing south corridor, bathrooms and connection to the new building.
- New foundation and exterior wall construction at the south wing removal location.
- Fire alarm upgrade and replacement throughout the entire facility.
- Final inspections for the new addition.
- Landscaping on the east side of the new building.

Finance Committee:

- To date, St. Paul has paid nearly \$5.1 million towards the ministry expansion project. Approximately \$1.3 million remains to be paid to Catalyst Construction, which will substantially be paid over the next three months.
- More than \$1.9 million in promissory notes have been issued to date. For those interested, St. Paul continues to issue promissory notes.
- St. Paul has begun borrowing from Lutheran Church Extension Fund ("LCEF") to assist financing the remainder of the ministry expansion project through its completion. St. Paul has borrowed \$600,000 in principal and paid interest to LCEF of \$2,086.
